

Master of Forensic Medicine Minimum Entry Requirements

Qualifications

To be eligible for admission, you must meet all of the following minimum entry requirements for the relevant stream. Applicants who do not meet these requirements cannot be considered for entry.

Clinical Forensic Medicine

 A Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery AND current employment in clinical practice with a minimum of 3 years experience AND satisfactory proof of appropriate current professional medical registration in your current country of residency and practice (e.g. Australian Citizens & Permanent Resident Visa holders, must hold current professional registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Agency (AHPRA))

Forensic Odontology

 A Bachelor of Dentistry AND current employment in dental practice with a minimum of 3 years experience AND satisfactory proof of appropriate current professional dental registration in your current country of residency and practice (e.g. Australian Citizens & Permanent Resident Visa holders, must hold current professional registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Agency (AHPRA))

Forensic Medical Science

 Bachelor of Biomedical Science (Hons) AND current employment in a relevant laboratory setting with a minimum of two years experience

OR

 Bachelor of Science (Hons) AND current employment in a recognised forensic institute with a minimum of two years' experience or

OR

 Bachelor of Radiography and Medical Imaging (Hons) AND current employment in radiography practice with a minimum of 2 years experience AND satisfactory proof of appropriate current professional registration as a radiographer in your current country of residency and practice (e.g. Australian Citizens & Permanent Resident Visa holders, must hold current professional registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Agency (AHPRA))

English requirements

IELTS: 7.0 overall (no band lower than 6.5)
TOEFL Paper-based test: 600 with a TWE of 5.0

TOEFL Internet-based test: score of 100 overall with minimum scores: Writing: 24,

Listening: 20, Reading: 20 and Speaking: 20
