

Master of Forensic Medicine Minimum Entry Requirements

Qualifications

To be eligible for admission, you must meet all of the following minimum entry requirements for the relevant stream. Applicants who do not meet these requirements cannot be considered for entry.

Clinical Forensic Medicine

- A Bachelor of Medicine and Surgery AND current employment in clinical practice with a minimum of 3 years experience AND satisfactory proof of appropriate current professional medical registration in your current country of residency and practice (e.g. Australian Citizens & Permanent Resident Visa holders, must hold current professional registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Agency (AHPRA))

OR

- Bachelor of Nursing OR Master of Nursing AND current employment as a Registered Nurse in clinical nursing practice in a medical or surgical ward of a hospital with a minimum of three years experience AND Satisfactory proof of current professional registration as a Registered Nurse in your country of residency and practice (eg; Australian Citizens & Permanent Resident Visa holders must hold current professional registration as a Registered Nurse with the Nursing and Midwifery Board of Australia (NMBA) and Australian Health Practitioner Agency (AHPRA). Enrolled Nurses are not eligible to apply for entry to this course)

Forensic Odontology

- A Bachelor of Dentistry AND current employment in dental practice with a minimum of 3 years experience AND satisfactory proof of appropriate current professional dental registration in your current country of residency and practice (e.g. Australian Citizens & Permanent Resident Visa holders, must hold current professional registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Agency (AHPRA))

Forensic Medical Science

- Bachelor of Biomedical Science (Hons) AND current employment in a relevant laboratory setting with a minimum of two years experience

OR

- Bachelor of Science (Hons) AND current employment in a recognised forensic institute with a minimum of two years' experience or

OR

- Bachelor of Radiography and Medical Imaging (Hons) AND current employment in radiography practice with a minimum of 2 years experience AND satisfactory proof of appropriate current professional registration as a radiographer in your current country of residency and practice (e.g. Australian Citizens & Permanent Resident Visa holders, must hold current professional registration with the Australian Health Practitioner Agency (AHPRA))

English requirements

IELTS: 7.0 overall (no band lower than 6.5)

TOEFL Paper-based test: 600 with a TWE of 5.0

TOEFL Internet-based test: score of 100 overall with minimum scores: Writing: 24,

Listening: 20, Reading: 20 and Speaking: 20
